Greetings Friends and Family of LGLC,

For many years the members of Lake George Lutheran Chapel have discussed the possibility of building a parsonage. A parsonage is a churchowned home provided for a member of the clergy. While this was always a dream we never acted on that dream. The onset of Covid gave the leadership time to think about the positive nature of having a parsonage for the members of LGLC and the impact having the pastor living part-time on campus would have on the Lake George community. The Voters decided now was the time to undertake such an endeavor. Their timing must have been right, for the donations for the parsonage poured in. We want to thank all of our donors for their generosity. The resources became available to build a modest parsonage, a home for our pastor and future pastors.

The project unfolded rapidly. We broke ground in April and by mid-August the parsonage is nearly complete. We need to purchase a few furnishings and the parsonage will be ready for occupancy. Completing such a major project in four months reflects on the time and dedication of our members who gave oversight to the construction process. The care and concern for detail is evident in how lovely our new parsonage looks. Countless decisions were made to enhance the living space and to make our parsonage a home.

We all know the old saying, "Home is where the heart is." How true. When the wise men, the Magi, came to visit Jesus Matthew writes, "On coming to the house, they saw the child with His mother Mary, and they bowed down and worshipped Him" (Mt. 2:11). No longer was our Savior living in the stable, He was now residing in a home with His parents.

Having a home, a parsonage, makes a very important statement to our community and to those who serve us as pastors. A home evokes feelings of permanence, stability, love, caring and sharing. The Christian home is a place where Christ is present in all aspects of life. All of us, the members of LGLC, want our homes to be a place where Christ dwells in all of His fullness. The blessings of being a member of a Christian home are expressed so beautifully in the hymn:
